

### PURPOSE

This Privacy Policy is designed to help you understand what kind of information we collect in connection with our products and services and how we will process and use this information. In the course of providing you with products and services we will collect and process information that is commonly known as personal data.

This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, share, retain and safeguard personal data.

This Privacy Policy sets out your individual rights, we explain these later in the Notice but in summary these rights include your right to know what data is held about you, how this data is processed and how you can place restrictions on the use of your data.

### WHO ARE WE?

Inplus Securities Ltd ("Inplus Securities") is a company registered in Mauritius and is duly licensed by the Mauritius Financial Services Commission as Investment Dealer (Full-Service – Excluding Underwriting).

How does Inplus Securities process your personal data?

This policy explains how Inplus Securities handles personal information and complies with the requirements of the Mauritius Data Protection Act 2017 (the "Act"). If you have any further questions in relation to this policy, please contact us on <u>compliance@inplusglobal.com</u>.

### WHAT IS PERSONAL DATA?

Personal data is information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. Examples include an individual's name, age, address, date of birth, gender and contact details.

Personal data may contain information which is known as special categories of personal data. This may be information relating to an individual's health, racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, genetic and biometric data, or data relating to sexual orientation.

Personal data may also contain data relating to criminal convictions and offences.

## COLLECTING INFORMATION RELATING TO INDIVIDUALS

We will use your personal data for the performance of our contract with you, to provide you with our services as Investment Dealer (Full-Service – Excluding Underwriting), to administer your investments and our business, to respond to any requests from you about services we provide and to process complaints. We will also use your personal data to manage your account, perform statistical analysis on

the data we collect, for financial planning and business forecasting purposes and to develop new and market existing products and services.

We collect information relating to the contact details and organisational roles of our clients, suppliers and other business contacts. The information will relate to basic information of the person such as names, addresses (whether residential or business), mobile or telephone numbers, e-mail addresses (whether personal or work) and job designations.

The information we collect during the provision of our services to our clients would be of a more detailed nature such as financial information (income and net worth, financial projections), family background, source of wealth etc, amongst others

In most cases, the information we collect would be from the individuals with whom we deal and the medium are either through forms or other types of interaction whether by email, conversations or through thirds parties when there is no direct interaction.

## HOW WE DEAL WITH AND USE THE PERSONAL INFORMATION

Our main purposes for collecting personal information about individuals are:

- Providing our services;
- Responding to requests;
- Maintaining client relationship;
- Notifying clients of our product offerings and developments;
- Reporting and management;
- Compliance purposes (we share information with third parties such as world-check, KYC 360)
- Any purpose that would relate to our business

We may use personal information about individuals to market our services, including by email. However, individuals have the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for such marketing by emailing to us on priya@premierfinservices.com.

If we collect or use personal information in ways other than as stated in this policy, we will ensure we do so pursuant to the requirements of the Act.

### DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

Inplus Securities does not routinely disclose personal information to other organisations unless:

- required by law;
- use or disclosure is permitted by this policy;
- we believe it necessary to provide you with a product or service which you have requested or are contracted to;
- to protect the rights, property or personal safety of any member of the public or a customer of Inplus Securities or the interests of Inplus Securities; or
- you give your consent.

Except as set out in this policy, we do not sell or trade personal information to third parties or allow such third parties to use that personal information.

# TRANSFER OF INFORMATION OUTSIDE MAURITIUS

We may transfer your data to third parties based outside of Mauritius Area. This is necessary for the purposes of administering our business and/or managing your investments. Such parties are not permitted to use your personal data for any other purpose than for what has been agreed with us. These parties are also required to safeguard your personal data through the use of appropriate technical and organisational data security measures and are prohibited from disclosing or sharing your data with other third parties without our prior authorisation, or unless as required by law.

When you make a request to access personal information, we will require you to provide some form of identification (such as a driver's licence or passport) so we can verify that you are the person to whom the information relates.

In some cases we may also request an administrative fee to cover the cost of access.

If at any time you want to know what personal information we hold about you, you may contact us in writing or by email.

## RECTIFICATIONS, ERASURE OR RESTRICTION OF PROCESSING

If you believe that information we hold about you is incorrect or out of date, or if you have concerns about how we are handling your personal information, please contact us and we will try to resolve those concerns.

If you wish to have your personal information deleted, please let us know and we will take reasonable steps to delete it (unless we need to keep it for legal, auditing or internal risk management reasons).

If Inplus Securities becomes aware of any ongoing concerns or problems concerning our privacy practices, we will take these issues seriously and work to address these concerns.
